Occurs when sediment that has eroded is **DROPPED** in a new location.

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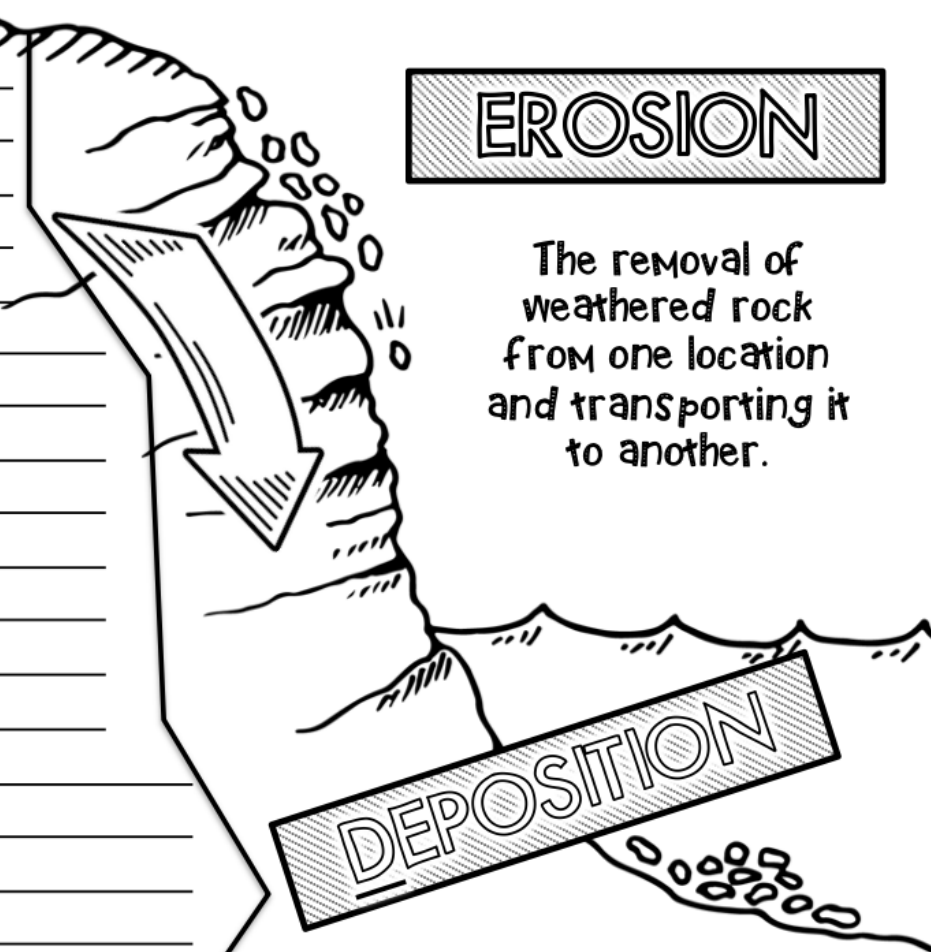
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
